**Murray's Melts** **Why we love it:** It was only a matter of time before New York's most venerable cheese shop jumped on the panini bandwagon. Go beyond basic grilled cheese (\$4) and mix and match nine meats, 14 cheeses, four breads, eight veggies and five add-on condiments, or choose from among the ten signature melts. **Top picks for \$10 and under:** The Great Cabot Roast features thinly shaved roast beef and top-of-the-line clothbound Cabot cheddar in between buttered Blue Ribbon Pullman bread (\$8.99). The What a Croque sandwich is a superdeluxe croque-monsieur with cave-aged Gruyère and a fried egg on top (\$6.99).
